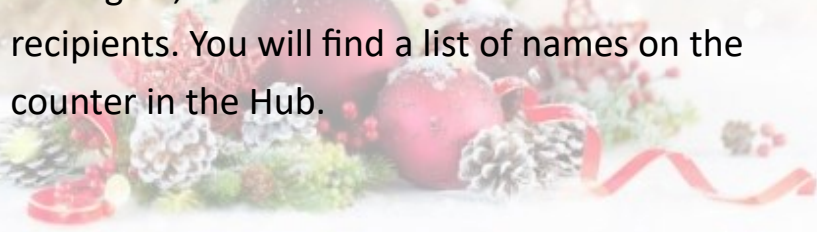
Shoebox Packing Party

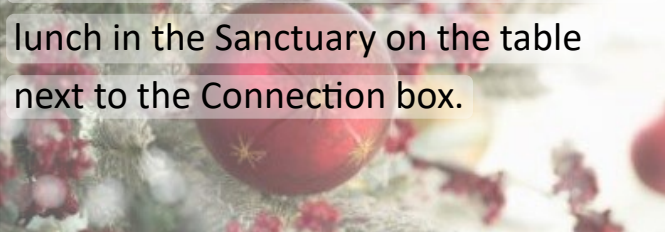
Christmas Bags (for At-Home Members)
