# From the Pastor...

Saying "goodbye" is hard, sometimes very hard. I experienced this personally in the homegoing of my daddy on February 2, 2024. After a 10-month battle with esophageal cancer, his faith was made sight, and the Lord ushered him into His eternal presence. But for as hard as it was to tell daddy "goodbye," I knew that it was what needed to happen, what *must* happen. The time had come. And my "goodbye" to daddy was only one side

of things. On the other side of things was a joyful "Hello" as the Lord welcomed him into that which human words cannot describe. Upon my dad's passing, I cried mightily, and in the same breath, I shouted "Hallelujah." Sometimes, saying that hard word "good bye" opens the door for something more glorious than we can ever imagine.

As a Calvary family, we have some "goodbyes" to say. They can be hard. It can be hard saying "goodbye" to the title "Baptist" in our church's name, a title which in years gone by served well to help define the beliefs and values and identity of the congregation. It can be hard saying "good bye" to our beloved brother Jim, now retiring in mid-April, who has served this congregation with full heart and soul for over 10 years. In such times, saying "goodbye" can leave us with a hole in our hearts, with concerns over the future and what it will look like, with a sense of loss of our past and the anticipation of change in our future.

But for those who have faith in Jesus, it should always be true that, as the Apostle Paul writes, "we do not grieve as those who have no hope." These "goodbyes" are also opportunities for God to open doors for something more glorious than we can ever imagine.

On Sunday, March 3, following worship, we will vote on the recommendation of your pastor and your deacons to change the name of this congregation to "Calvary Church." And, in the coming weeks, with Jim Burnett's final Sunday on April 21 in view, we will begin the process of discerning who it is that God will call to this church to lead us in worship. Both these involve some "goodbyes," but I anticipate that there is something on the other side that will raise up in us a shout of "Hallelujah!" Yes, weeping may last for the night, but JOY comes in the morning.

So, saying "goodbye" maybe isn't quite so hard when we know what's on the other side. And what is on the other side is going to be good... really, really good, isn't it!
